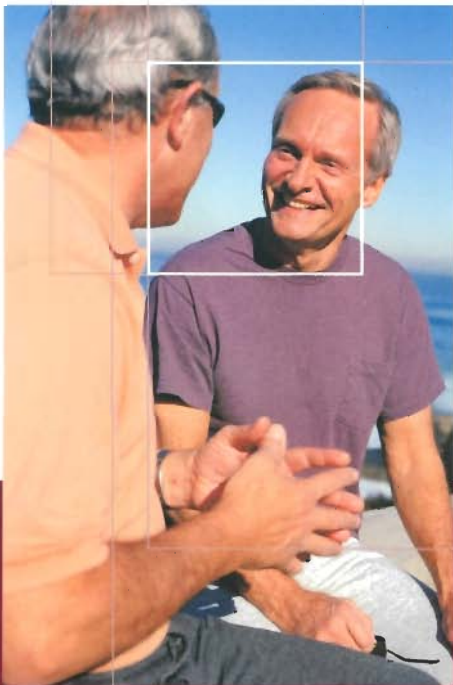


What is Man to Man?

- **Group Education and Support**
Man to Man is a forum for men to learn about prostate cancer diagnosis and treatment options – as well as coping and everyday living – through interactive presentations and materials. Specialists in various fields related to prostate cancer share information on medical topics and quality of life issues. A comfortable and confidential meeting environment encourages men and their families to discuss their concerns openly and honestly and to share solutions to common problems. Support groups for spouses are also available in many areas. No medical advice is offered.

One-on-one patient support from specially trained prostate cancer survivors.
